- Complete online application form at www.johnmolson.concordia.ca/giim/
- Bachelor's Degree with GPA 3.0 or better (75% average)
- GMAT Results (550 or better)
- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or IELTS (international English Language Testing System) results for international students, if necessary
TOEFL: 600 (paper-based) or 250 (computer-based) or better, IELTS: 6.5 or better. Institution code is 0956 for both tests.
- Letter explaining your commitment to the Program
- Two letters of recommendation from business or academic professionals
- Proof of citizenship. (International students are welcome)
- Non-refundable application fee

Tuition for the Goodman Institute 3-year program is CA \$16,000 per year.

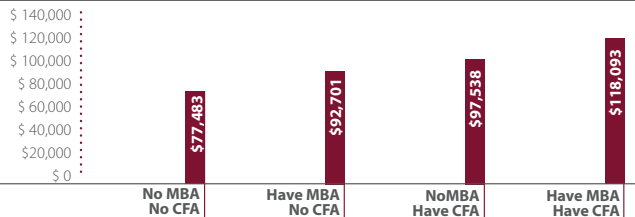
